James Zeman has secured hangar space for the Tri-motor. Amway Corp. has generously donated one of their hangars for this purpose. The Tri-motor will arrive on June 8<sup>th</sup> with media flights on June 11<sup>th</sup>. The tours & flight loading will be at Rapid Air's Hangar location on Jun 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers to help with all aspects of the tour are needed. The advertising at the Festival of the Arts program on the weekend before the Tri-motor tour will be provided.

### YOUNG EAGLES

A rally was conducted at the Kalamazoo Air Zoo on May 2. Operations went from 8am to 3pm with a total of 133 young eagles flown. Something new for this year was that in cooperation with Sporty's Air, each new young eagle received a beginner's flight log book with an access code to their online ground school program. This is a free offer and is worth several hundred dollars if purchased retail. The next rally will be at Greenville Airport on May 30<sup>th</sup>. As part of the young eagles program is the accumulation of cash credits for the chapter to sponsor the participation of selected young eagles in the EAA air academy. To date, the chapter has accrued \$1615.00 in credits

Congratulations to Dick Foster in being recognized by the National organization of EAA for his participation and volunteer work in providing introductions to the world of flying for over 1000 young eagles.
